Instructions to candidates appearing for the Written Test to be held on 17.03.24

- 1. The Written Test will be held at the Wildlife Institute of India, Chandrabani, Dehradun 248001, Uttarakhand. The institute is located 1.6 km from the Dehradun-Delhi NH, about 3 km from the Inter State Bus Terminus (ISBT), about 10 km from the Dehradun Railway Station; and about 25 km from the Dehradun airport.
- The short-listed candidates are required to report at the institute by 0830 hrs on Sunday, 17 March 2024. The institute will not provide accommodation for candidates appearing in the written test.
- 3. All candidates to carry a valid photo ID card issued by the Government of India (Aadhar, Passport, PAN Card, DL etc.). Persons accompanying candidates will not be allowed inside the institute campus.
- 4. No candidate will be allowed to enter the institute with any bag, pen/pencil and electronic items such as laptop, mobile phones, smart watch, head phones etc. The institute will not take any responsibility for any personal belongings. However, candidates are advised to bring their own water bottle. The institute will provide pen to all candidates for the examination.
- 5. Before entering the examination hall, all candidates have to sign the attendance sheet and collect their hall tickets.
- 6. The written test will be of 2:30 hours duration from **1030 hrs to 1300** hrs. The proceedings of the written test will be video-graphed.

Syllabus and Format

The written test would comprise of Essay (20 marks) and Multiple Choice Questions (50 marks).

Essays (10 X 2 = 20 marks) (800 - 1000 words) would have to be written on any two topics that are covered under the following subject areas/ disciplines: Wildlife Sociology, Human dimension in Wildlife Conservation, Veterinary Science & Wildlife Health, and Wildlife Ecology.

The Multiple Choice Questions would be in two Sections

Section A Research Methodology (1 X 20 = 20 marks) covering research hypothesis, research methods, data analysis, statistics;

Section B Subject Knowledge (1 X 30 = 30 marks) covering the subjects/ disciplines: Wildlife Sociology, Human dimension in Wildlife Conservation, Veterinary Science & Wildlife Health, and Wildlife Ecology.

There will negative marking of - 0.25 marks for every wrong answer.
