Terms and Conditions:

- 1) The headquarter for the above post would be Wildlife Institute of India (WII), Dehradun. However, the selected candidate would be liable to serve at any location decided by the Institute as per functional needs of the Tiger Cell.
- 2) The offer of contractual engagement will be initially for a period of one year which may be extended depending upon the requirement in the Tiger Cell and on the basis of performance of the contractual engagee.
- 3) The job requires extensive traveling to forest interiors, wildlife areas and arduous terrain across India.
- 4) The medical reimbursement through government approved medical practioners will be provided subject to a maximum cost ceiling of Rs.15,000/- per annum during the contractual period of one year. A mediclaim policy will be provided by the Institute subject to a maximum premium of Rs.15,000/-. An accidental insurance policy for a maximum amount of Rs.10.00 lakhs will also be provided by the Institute.
- 5) Shortlisted candidates will have to produce original certificates furnished in their applications at the time of interview.
- 6) The candidates are required to give a fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) for each contractual position. Applications received after the last date and without requisite fee, unsigned applications, incomplete applications and applications not in prescribed

format will be rejected.

- 7) Mere fulfillment of the minimum advertised qualifications and experience requirement DOES NOT automatically entitles an applicant to be called for interview.
- 8) Selection of the candidates shall be made on the basis of screening of application received by due date followed by a test and interview. The test for the eligible applicants shall be conducted in the Institute campus at Dehradun.
