- This is only an eligibility test. Admission to Ph. D., programme in the Discipline of Wildlife Science at Wildlife Institute of India will be as per the provision of Ph. D., Ordinance of the Saurashtra University.
- Selected candidates are requested to prepare a synopsis of their Ph.D., proposal and defend the same before the Research Degree Committee (RDC) in its meeting to be held during the second week of December 2014 at WII. The exact date of the RDC Meeting will be informed to the selected candidates by e-mail. The Ph.D., proposal should include the title, name of the Ph.D., guide from Wildlife Institute of India, Introduction, Literature Review, Study area, Methodology, Data Analysis, Expected Outcome, Tentative Work Plan and References.
- External research scholars should clearly mention the time frame of the proposed Ph.D. Research Work. External research scholars defending their synopsis before the RDC in December 2014 must possess approval of funding agency to support for conducting the Ph.D. Research Work. A head-wise budget break up including field visits of the supervisor(s) must be provided in the budgetary details.
