How to Apply: Please read instructions carefully before filling online form. You may fill Online Application Form from Green Skill Development Programme Portal (<http://gsdp-envis.gov.in/Default3.aspx>). Applications received after last date i.e. **05.02.2020 (till 1500 hrs.)** will not be considered by screening committee.

Selection of Candidates: Screening Committee would screen all applications and list of candidates shortlisted for the interview will be uploaded on the website www.wiienvis.nic.in (in latest news section) on **6th February, 2020**. Date, venue and time of interview would be intimated separately to shortlisted candidates. No reimbursements will be provided for attending the interview.

Selection Criteria:

First preference would be given to applicants who are unemployed, lower income group and residing in and around Protected Areas of Uttarakhand & other neighbouring states. If we don't find adequate candidates from these states then applicants from other states would be called for interview.

Course Objective:

The course aims at imparting knowledge and skills on Remote Sensing, GIS and GPS with their use and applications in the wildlife management field.

Course Fee:

No course fee, it is FREE programme (including boarding and lodging), sponsored by ENVIS Secretariat, MoEF&CC, New Delhi.

Course Module:

The Course module includes Theory, Practical, Lab Works, Project Work and Field Visits. Course materials will be provided to all participants.

Evaluation and Assessment:

The candidates will be assessed and evaluated based on their performances in both written and practical examinations. Certificates will be issued to all trainees after successful completion of the course.
