5	Desirable Qualification (DQ)	 (1) Research experience in Wildlife Sciences Experience of conducting floral and faunal survey, Proficiency in using computers and good writing skill in English language. (2) Must be able to do field work in remote field conditions.
6	Description of Work	Collate ecological information on the wetlands of Chhattisgarh on the following: i) Broad geographic delineation of the wetland ii) Its Zone of Influence (ZOI) along with a map (accurate and to scale) iii) Brief ecological and geographical features including area, depth, catchment, biodiversity, use value, etc iv) Threats to wetland v) Account of pre-existing rights and privileges, consistent or not consistent with the ecological health of the wetland
7	Age	Shall not be more than 32 Years on date of interview. Age relaxation: The upper age limit may be relaxed up to 5 years as per Government of India rules.

8	Emoluments	Rs. 20,000 per month + allowances for House, Telephone, Transport, Medical and Accidental Insurance as per Institute's Rules, not exceeding Rs. 5,000/- per month.
9	Funding agency	Forest Department, Government of Chhattisgarh
10	Terms of References	The fellowship tenure will be governed by the Institute's rules and regulations
