6	Age	Shall not be more than 28 years. The upper age limit may be relaxed up to 5 years as per Government of India rules.

The candidate opted for Interview in Person, should report at WII on 17th February, 2017 at 9.30 hrs with a copy of their filled-in application with attested true copies of testimonials of educational qualifications, research experience along with certificate of extracurricular activities, date of birth, mark sheets of all examinations etc. All original documents/certificates must be produced at the time of registration for necessary verification.
- 4. At the time of the verification of original documents (even after selection), if it is found that an attempt has been made by the applicant to wilfully conceal, misrepresent or canvass the facts, such applicant will not be considered for selection and due action will be taken.
- 5. No TA/DA and accommodation will be paid for attending the Interview and the candidate should bear the cost of Skype call.
