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NOTICE INVITING TENDER

On behalf of Director of Wildlife Institute of India, Government of India, sealed bids are invited for disposal of surplus Livefood such as crickets, mealworm, and mice being produced at the Bustard Conservation breeding centre at Jaisalmer, Rajasthan on "As-is-where-is-basis".

A. General:

1. Tender Document can be downloaded from the website (www.wii.gov.in).

B. Details of Auction:

1. The surplus livefood is available at Bustard Conservation Breeding Centre, Jaisalmer, Rajasthan. Details of contact person for inspection and tender accepting authority are as under:

2. An EMD of Rs. 70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand only) should be deposited with the tender in the form of an Account Payee Bank Draft/Pay order from any Nationalized bank in favorof "The Director, Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun"

C. General Terms & Conditions:

- 1. Intended Bidders may inspect the location/ livefood on the stipulated dates & time.
- The items shall be sold to the highest bidder. The bids are invited for all livefood produced at the Conservation Breeding centre, i.e. crickets, mealworm, and mice etc. as a whole, and no bid would be accepted for any part of the same.
- The offer to the highest bidder will be provided initially for a period of one year which can be extended further as per the requirement of the institute.
- 4. The surplus livefood to the highest bidder selected will be sold on two-monthly basis.
- 5. The successful bidder has to make the payment within first ten days of the month.
- The earnest money Deposit (EMD) of successful bidder shall be released after the completion of the contract.
- No item once disposed to the successful bidder shall be taken back on any condition whatsoever.
- 8. The successful bidder will be required to lift all the livefood from the disposal site within five days after making the payment. On failure to do so this office shall have the right to forfeit the entire amount of the bidder and dispose of the items through the alternate bidder. The successful bidder, on their own cost, will also be required to make their own arrangement of transport, labour etc. for lifting the disposed livefood.
- Approximate surplus production (extra quantities after feeding captive birds) that is to be disposed. These quantities will tentatively be: 400 individuals of mice, 12 kg of cricket and 15 kg of mealworm; however exact amounts will vary at each disposal exercise.
- 10. Quotation letter in the sealed envelope super subscribed "Tender for Disposal of Surplus Livefood of Bustard Conservation Breeding Centre at Jaisalmer, Rajasthan" addressed to Registrar, Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun should be sent to "Wildlife Institute of India, Chandrabani, Post-Mohbewala, Dehradun -248002". "This office will not be responsible for any postal/courier delay and also for the reasons beyond the control of this office"
- 11. Tenders received after the due date and time due to any reason whatsoever shall not be considered.

- 12. The financial bid should be given in both in figures and words. Any overwriting or erasing in the figures shall not be considered for acceptance of the rates offered by the tenderer.
- 13. The Wildlife Institute of India reserves the right to accept or reject any/all quotations without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 14. Each page of tender document should be signed by the bidder(s).
- 15. Incomplete and unsigned quotations are liable to be rejected.
- 16. Bidder must enclose copy of address proof (Voter I-card/Aadhar Card/Driving License etc.) and PAN card along with the bid.
- 17. An earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 70,000/- (Rupees seventy thousand only) must accompany the quotation, without which the relevant bid shall be summarily rejected. " EMD does not bear nay interest and will be returned to unsuccessful bidders"
- 18. GST: GST shall also be payable by the bidder on the total quoted price and shall be charged as per rules.
- 19. All relevant rules and regulations of Government of India will be final and applicable & binding on all bidders.
- 20. Bidder may invariably share their telephone no., email, mobile no. and address to facilitate communication.

21. Force Majeure

A) However, the Agency shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages or termination for default, if and to the extent that, it's delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.

B) For purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Agency and not involving the Agency's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but are not limited to, acts of the Institute either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.

C) If a Force Majeure situation arises, the Agency shall promptly notify the Institute in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Institute

in writing, the Agency shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.

- 22. Resolution of Disputes: All disagreements, disputes, difference that may arise between the Wildlife Institute of India and the agency which cannot be resolved through mutual negotiations shall be referred to an Arbitrator appointed in accordance with the provisions of relevant Indian Law. The venue of the proceedings and arbitration shall be Dehradun, Uttarakhand, India.
- 23. Jurisdiction: The obligations and liabilities arising out of this contract shall be construed in accordance with the laws of Union of India. The Court in Dehradun, Uttarakhand, India shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try all or any of the dispute.
- 24. Each Bidder should clearly specify that the Bidder agrees to abide by the conditions of this tender document on their printed letter head with telephone/fax numbers and e- mail, etc.
