On April 6, 2018, the 2 judge's divisional bench of Justice Rajiv Sharma and Justice Lok Pal Singh passed a landmark order restricting the joy rides in Corbett national park, Ramnagar, Uttarakhand. The order is really appreciable and safeguards the interest of animals.

The court directed the Wildlife Institute of Dehradun to carry out survey within three months to assess the carrying capacity of these zones to know the number of vehicles which can be permitted to ply to avoid minimum disturbance to the wildlife.
