

Information on Great Indian Bustard

- 1) These action plans should be requested to respective Chief Wildlife Wardens of the States mentioned in the RTI. These are not available with WII.
- 2) There are no known GIB breeding sites within Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka. Breeding in Gujarat isn't possible since there are no male birds currently recorded. In Rajasthan breeding population of Great Indian Bustard is found within the District of Jaisalmer (Desert National Park and Ramdeora).
- 3) The following map provides the critical bustard habitat within Rajasthan and the major power sector companies operating in the region to the best of our knowledge. The major powerlines of these companies within the GIB Arc are mapped and provided.

- 4) The major power lines within the only remaining habitat in Abdasa, Kachchh, Gujarat are provided in the attached map. The red dots are satellite locations of tagged GIB and the blue dots are GIB locations recorded by visual sighting of birds. The powerlines are marked in red and white lines
