M.Sc. COURSE IN WILDLIFE SCIENCE

The Wildlife Institute of India (www.wii.gov.in) is a premier national institute for training, research and advisory services in the field of wildlife conservation and management. The Institute offers a nationally and internationally acclaimed 2 years residential M.Sc. Course in 'Wildlife Science'. The Institute invites applications from eligible Indian and foreign candidates having passion for wildlife and conservation for this prestigious course for the year 2021-2023.

THE COURSE

The Institute's flagship M.Sc. course in Wildlife Science is widely acclaimed both nationally and internationally. This course aims to impart both theoretical and practical knowledge on concepts, principles, approaches, analytical skills and field techniques in Wildlife Science. The course is affiliated with the Saurashtra University, Rajkot (Gujarat) which has been Accredited Grade 'A' by NAAC. This course is open to both Indian and foreign nationals of high calibre, motivation and having passion for wildlife and conservation. Applications are invited for admission to this 2-year residential course (four semesters) in M.Sc. Wildlife Science commencing on 01st July, 2021.

NUMBER OF SEATS

Twenty (20) meritorious students will be admitted to this course, which includes 15 Indian and 05 foreign nationals. The break-up of seats is as follows:

General — 08; SC — 02; ST — 01; OBC— 04; Foreign — 05.

In case of 5 foreign candidates are not selected, these seats will be offered to Indian candidates as per the reservation policy of Government of India.

ELIGIBILITY

Bachelor's degree in Science, Medical Science, Engineering, Veterinary Science, Agriculture, Forestry, Pharmacy, Social Science and Computer Science or degrees recognized as equivalent thereof. Applicants from the fields of Engineering, Social Science, Computer science etc. Should have biology as one the subjects in Higher Secondary Education Board or other equivalent board.

Minimum of 15 years of formal education (either 10+2+3 or 11+2+2).

Candidates who have completed the graduation degree in any of the above disciplines with a pass certificate.

Candidates who have completed the graduation degree in any of the above disciplines with a pass certificate, or who have appeared OR will be appearing at the qualifying (final) bachelor's degree examination and whose result is still awaited may also apply. However, they need to provide their Graduation Pass Certificate prior to the registration in the course at Saurashtra University, tentatively by 01st August 2021, failing which the admission will stand cancelled.

AGE LIMIT

Not more than 25 years as on July 01, 2021 with relaxation of 5 years for reserved category candidates (SC/ST/OBC). For the in-service candidates working in Forest and Wildlife Departments, the age limit is 35 years as on July 01, 2021.

For the foreign candidates upper age limit is 28 years as on 01st July 2021.

SELECTION PROCESS

Indian Candidates : Eligible candidates will be required to appear for an online National Eligibility Test (NET) in any one of the 10 Centres (Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Bhopal, Mumbai, Delhi, Lucknow, Dehra Dun, Kolkata, Guwahati and Jammu) on date fixed for examination.. The NET will be for 2 hours duration for 100 marks. The question paper would have the following sections:

- 1) Section 1 : 30 multiple choice questions on General Awareness including Current Affairs, Quantitative Skills, English Language and Computer knowledge (30 marks).
- 2) Section 2 : 40 multiple-choice questions on environment, forest, wildlife and conservation issues (40 marks).
- 3) Section 3 : a 200 word essay on environmental, forest, wildlife or conservation issue (30 marks).

Shortlisted candidates based on NET screening will be called to take a Personality and Aptitude Test (PAT) and interview at Dehra Dun on date fixed. Final selection to the course will be made on the basis of combined merit of 70% marks obtained in the NET and 30% of PAT. Shortlisted candidates belonging to "General Category" will be interviewed on date fixed, while shortlisted reserved category (SC/ST/OBC) candidates will be interviewed on date fixed.

The selected Indian nationals will have to confirm their joining in the course i.e acceptance of selection offer positively on the date fixed by email. Failing which, the wait listed candidates in appropriate lists will be offered the seat.

Candidates should note that their candidature is provisional. Their candidature will be deemed final upon verification of eligibility condition with reference to the documents enclosed with their application and as required by the Saurashtra University and payment of First Semester Fee in case of Self sponsored candidates.

Foreign Nationals : All eligible foreign candidates will be interviewed through skype or video conferencing following which their final selection will be made. For foreign nationals, the tentative interview dates through web conferencing are between the dates fixed. The foreign candidates will inform the preference of the interview date through web conferencing and provide complete contact details. The final merit list will be based on 50% marks in the Graduation degree and 50% marks obtained in interview (Maximum marks - 100) based on web conferencing.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Institute provides full scholarship to eight Indian students based on their merit during selection. The scholarship covers academic fee, hostel accommodation fee and a monthly stipend of Rs. 3,000/- per month. The breakup of the scholarships for Indian nationals will be: Gen.- 04; SC- 01; ST- 01 and OBC - 02.

Other candidates (Indian and Foreign) selected for the course will be treated as self-sponsored. The self sponsored students would be required to pay the course fee in four equal installments prior to commencement of each semester.
