Certified photocopy of approval of Finance Ministry in respect of grant of annual additional funds to be required to meet out the enhanced expenditure after filling up the newly created additional posts. 5. Certified photocopy of specific delegation of Administrative/Financial powers which provides authority to filling up the advertised posts which are not available for recruitment as per the provisions of existing rules.
