1. What is the cost involved for each radio collared tiger/ tigress by WII with NTCA approval to all Tiger States till date, with proportion of NTCA and respective State Forest Department.	The question is vague. Unable to understand what information is required. However, based on understanding, the cost of radio collar varies with respect to various components of the collar. The cost of collars depend on what is being asked by user. For Maharashtra the initial project cost was 70:30 from NTCA & Maharashtra Forest Department. For other project, all the cost is borne by State.
