2. What is the current bird population of Passer domesticus, Pycnonotus, Haliastur indus, Streptopelia and Pavo cristatus in the whole country?	The species in question have a wide distribution range across the country and the current population for the same in the whole country is not available.
3. Give the geographical distribution and the Conservation status of Passer domesticus, Pycnonotus, Haliastur indus, Streptopelia and Pavo cristatus.	Please refer a report "State of India's Bird Report 2020" ( <a href="https://www.stateofindiabirds.in">https://www.stateofindiabirds.in</a> ).
4. Describe the initiatives taken by the government in last 5 years to promote the population of birds and specially for the birds mentioned above.	The government has taken number of initiatives to promote the population of many highly threatened bird species that include the Great Indian Bustard, Lesser Florican, White-rumped Vulture, Long-billed Vulture, Slender-billed Vulture. Apart from several habitat improvement and protection measures, the government has established conservation breeding centres and has been successful in increasing the population of above mentioned species. For the select species in question the government has been actively promoting the celebration of World Sparrow Day conducted every year on 20th March to raise awareness and help bring back the population of the species. Information for other species is not available.
5. Give the details of last 3 years for the deaths of birds by mobile radiation in the whole country.	No information is available at Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun
