CPIO has may be misquoted or misinterpreted Section 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act 2005</p> <p>Provided that the information, which cannot be denied to the Parliament or a State Legislature shall not be denied to any person. wherein the Service Record is a Public Information, all the officers are dfined u/s 21 of the IPC</p> <p>Section 21 of the Indian Penal Code defines the term 'public servant</p> <p>he competent authority, every arbitrator and every officer empowered by the Central Government or the competent authority, while exercising any power or performing any duty under this Act, shall be deemed to be a public servant within the meaning of section 21 of the Indian Penal Code (45 of 1860).</p> <p>None of the Officer are on private Salary and their services are rendered to serve public.</p> <p>2. Delhi High Court Dated 16.01.2021 upheld in The Delhi High Court has opined that whenever information is sought under the Right To Information Act, disclosure of interest in the information sought is necessary (Hari Kishan v. President Secretariat). the information Date of Birth, Father name, family member name.</p> <p>3. Also that the Address of the Public Servants is also can not be refused as the Contempt Petition requires officer incharge personal address to be mentioned alongwith officials address.</p> <p>4. That no personal information has been sought from the CPIO, service record of the officers is as such that it can not be refused to Legislation or to Parliament, hence may not be denied to citizens of the country neither</p> <p>5. WII doesnt falls in the expempted category list, or disclosing this information has any relation whatsoever to cause national threat, CPIO has misquoted and misinterpreted this section of the act.</p> <p>RELIEF SOUGHT CPIO be directed to dispose off the Information expeditiously</p>
