1. Appellant filed RTI Application	:	Manual RTI Application No. –NIL—dated 19 April 2022
2. CPIO replied RTI	:	Vide letter No. WII/RTI/CPIO/2022-23 (Qtr-I)/10 dated 10 May 2022
3. Appellant filed Appeal Application	:	Manual Appeal No. –NIL-- dated 09 June 2022 against RTI reply vide Letter No. WII/RTI/CPIO/2022-23 (Qtr-I)/10 dated 10 May 2022
4. Ground for filing Appeal	:	(i) Information was sought from WII through RTI to provide all records/documents including note-sheet(s) of the File No.: AI2-1/90-WII-V (1996-97), as the records of the above mentioned file is of utmost importance and urgently required by our Legal Counsel towards our legal hearing in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India (ii) The response of the CPIO is inadequate and concerned officials cannot simply shirk away from their responsibilities by just saying "Information is not available in records of Administration Section". (iii) Sir, your urgent intervention is of utmost importance to direct all concerned officials to provide the required information without any further delay so that the same shall be submitted to the Apex Court within due time of legal hearing.

5. After due deliberation on the points of the appeal, the following decision is hereby made:

i. The reply/information provided by the CPIO (RTI) to the applicant is found to be correct.

Hence, the appeal is disposed off. If the Appellant is not satisfied with the above decision, he may approach to the Hon'ble Central Information Commission, New Delhi for second appeal.
