Please refer to your application cited above under RTI Act, 2005 which was received offline from Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, M.P. Satpuda Bhawan Bhopal, M.P.on 11-07-2023 at Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun.

In this context, this is to inform you that, the Great Indian Bustard is Critically Endangered with extinction and the requested information is of sensitive nature, whose revelation can lead to disturbances and poaching, compromising ongoing conservation efforts for the species. Citizen science records of the species in E-bird is also not accessible to public without case-to-case ratification on exceptional grounds. Further, no WII document consolidating the records of GIB from 1800 to March 2023 with requested details, is available for sharing.

In case, you are not satisfied with the aforesaid reply, you may appeal to the Appellate Authority as per details given below within 30 days from the date of receipt of this letter.
